

HSK Testing Requirements & Procedures

Requirements for the At Home HSK Test.

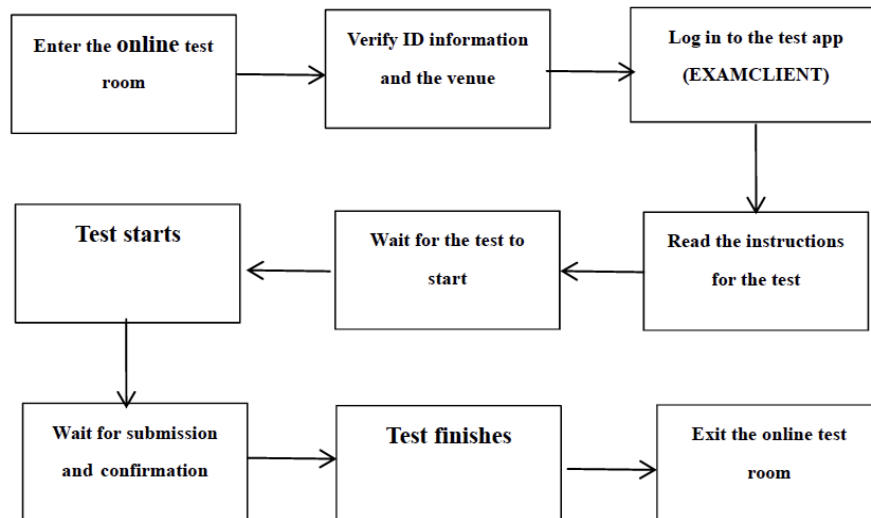
1. Cross-border test-taking is not allowed. Test takers must confirm they are in the local country of the registered test center when taking an At Home IBT on the day of the test. If a student is found taking the test across borders, the test results will be rendered invalid.

2. Test takers will need a computer installed with a **Windows (7/10) operating system**, a mobile phone/tablet, and a **wired** microphone and speaker. You will be asked to download the *ExamClient* onto a computer and join a proctored zoom meeting room using a mobile phone/tablet.

3. Test takers will need to take a mock test one week before the test date. This is to ensure the test taker is familiar with the procedures and platform so that they have the best chance of success!

Testing Procedures.

You must enter the proctored online test room (zoom meeting) **one hour** before the start of the mock test as well as the official test and follow the steps below.



Please place your mobile phone/tablet at an angle, as shown in the picture below. This is to ensure the proctor can see you and the computer screen throughout the entire test.
